

# Create a Climate for Peace Campaign

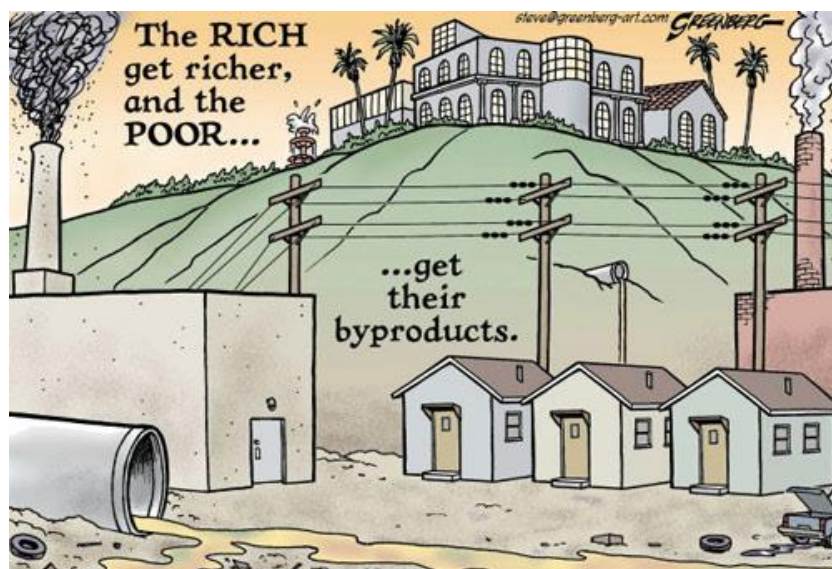


## Call for Volunteer Coordinator

Voluntary Service International (VSI) has joined SCI's international **"Create a Climate for Peace Campaign" (CCPC)** and is looking for a volunteer to help us coordinate VSI's involvement in the project.

### The Campaign

The Create a Climate for Peace Campaign is a worldwide campaign of SCI partners, branches and working groups starting in 2014. Its main aims are contributing to the transformation of our cultures from consumerism and violence towards sustainability and peace on all levels. The campaign consists of related activities within workcamps and ways to spread the application of related knowledge and tools. In addition to this main action in workcamps, two projects covering the whole world have been designed to build the capacity for climate justice action.



## The Volunteer

The selected volunteer will coordinate the special CCPC International Volunteer Project which will take place from July 21<sup>st</sup> – 31<sup>st</sup>. The workcamp will involve 15 adult volunteers in a volunteering and non-formal education project, and will take place in Ireland's only eco-village, in Cloughjordan, Co Tipperary. The Coordinator will –

- Organise the day-to-day programme of the workcamp;
- Liaise with the local community and the Cloughjordan Community Farm supervisor;
- Support volunteers in their involvement in the programme;
- Ensure the “climate justice” theme is integrated throughout all elements of the project (food, travel, content, etc.....);
- Communicate any serious issues or grievances to VSI staff.

The volunteer should fit the following criteria;

- Have an interest and understanding of the theme of climate justice;
- Have experience of working with diverse groups of people, including young people with fewer opportunities;
- Have good problem-solving and communication skills;
- Be available for and commit to the entire cycle of the project (preparation, implementation and evaluation).

The volunteer should be available to attend a training course which will take place in Rome, Italy from April 22<sup>nd</sup>- 29<sup>th</sup>. The training will give the volunteer the opportunity to meet other volunteer coordinators, to develop skills in group dynamics and conflict resolution, and to better understand the core theme of the CCP Campaign.
